Math – Predict how many different outfits you could wear with a set of colored shirts and shorts. Complete your work on the worksheet provided.

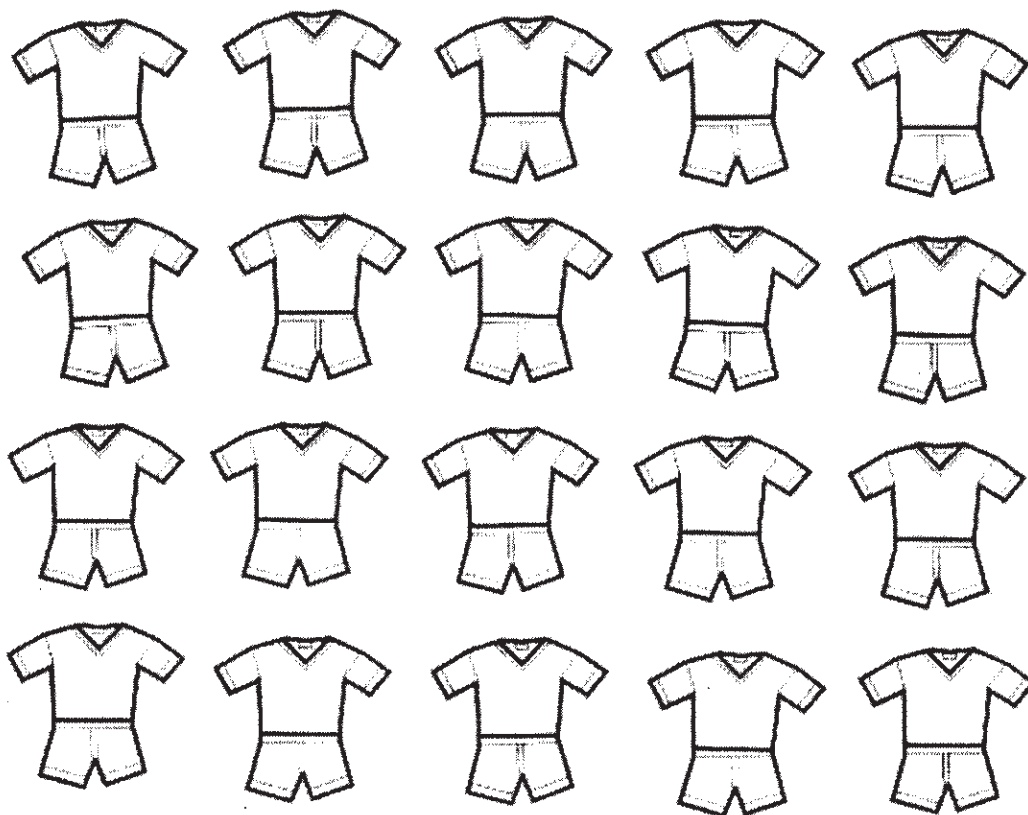
Shorts and Shirts Activity Sheet
