As the holidays approach, we are embarking on our school-wide service project, Cougars SHARE Holiday Gifts. We will be asking the East Amwell School Community for donations to buy gifts for needy children in Hunterdon and neighboring counties of New Jersey. A local social services organization will distribute the gifts to the children before the holidays. Our service project will involve the entire community. Students will be involved with collecting money, buying gifts at Toys R Us, wrapping the gifts, and donating them to an agency which helps disadvantaged youths. The highlights of this worthwhile effort are outlined below.

- Shopping trip to Toys R Us supervised by teachers, peer leaders and chaperones.


