Retailers give the PTO a percentage of each card purchased. Percentages are listed next to each retailer. Last month, the PTO profited \$339.

Gift cards make perfect gifts for many different people. They are great stocking stuffers for the hard-to-buy-for teenager. **The Gift Cards will be delivered in time for the holiday season.** Many of the stores listed are those we shop at on a regular basis. The Shop-Rite gift cards are always a big seller. We all need groceries!

Print additional Family Order Forms located on the school's website in the virtual backpack and share them with friends, coworkers, and family members.

The PTO orders gift cards MONTHLY.

Detailed ordering steps:

1. The Family Order Form will be sent out the **FIRST WEDNESDAY** of the month (Dec. 2).
2. Return the Family Order Form by the **SECOND WEDNESDAY** of the month (Dec. 9). Return forms and payment to school in an envelope labeled **PTO GIFT CARD PROGRAM**. Cash and checks are accepted, however we prefer checks for safety reasons.
3. Pickup for the Gift Cards will be the **THIRD WEDNESDAY** of the month (De. 16). **Please indicate on the order form the time you are planning on picking up the cards, so we can schedule accordingly.** Pickup times are 3:15-3:40 and 6:15-7:00pm in the cafeteria. If you cannot come during those times, or if you choose, the gift cards will be sent home in your child's backpack the next school day. *The PTO is not responsible for lost gift cards.*
