1:1 Chromebook Device Pilot Program Introduction



Dear Students, Parents/Guardians,

East Amwell Township School is happy to announce that we are expanding our 1:1 chromebook program by now permitting students in grades 7th and 8th to take their Chromebooks home. Each student will be responsible for their assigned device and will be expected to bring it to school each day. Students will be able to take their devices home beginning the week of February 3rd, 2020. Students will be required to return them during state testing dates and at the end of the school year. Specific dates will be set by the school and provided by the Middle School teachers.

Beginning in September 2020, students will be asked to pay a non refundable \$20.00 device usage and maintenance fee to cover the costs of damage and repairs. However, for the remainder of this year the usage and maintenance fee will not apply.
