Budget provides continuation of our guiding principle "All the Children, All the Time"

BUDGET PRIORITIES

- Academic Support Programs to ensure student growth and provide early interventions as needed
- Maintain academic programs and services including:
 - > Full Day Kindergarten, Integrated Preschool, Extended School Year
 - Early Intervention, Basic Skills, Tutorial, Counseling Support
 - Spanish Grades 3-8, Enrichment, Specials
 - No fee co curricular & extra curricular activities
 - Paraprofessionals for special needs students and student support
- Life Skills program for special needs students
- Continued provision of enhanced educational experiences
 - Peer Leaders, Character Education, EATV, Field Trips, Participation in Cougar Share, Band & Chorus
- Maintain average class size
 - ➤ Grades K-3 = 17
 - ➤ Grades 4-6 =16
 - \rightarrow Grades 7-8 = 14
- Participation in School Choice Program
- Use of Emergency Reserve and Grant funds for Wireless Access upgrade to improve security throughout the District



OPERATING REVENUES 2023 - 2024



- Additional Preschool Classroom for 2023-2024




